An Addiction Crisis**

- 48 Million with a Substance Use Disorder
- Lethality of Opioids are a Historic Add On
- 23% Increase in Alcohol Deaths 2018 to 2021
- 300,000* Deaths Annually (all substances)
- 800 Deaths Each Day from "Overdose" Poisoning

 - Consumer Uncertainty of Need and Value


